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SALVdC's First Co-ed Weekend

The next SALVdC weekend, being held October 15-18, 2009, will be co-ed for the first time. Secretariat is very excited and hopeful that this new spin on our 3 day movement will stimulate more involvement and allow a different approach for presenting our Lord's message to all.

Secretariat discussed this weekend for a year. They set up the following ground rules:

- there will be a maximum of 24 participants (hoping for 12 men and 12 women)
- participants will be chosen by application date, with married couples having priority over single persons
- the Essentials of the weekend will remain the same
- there will be one Rector/a
- it is requested that the Rector/a call a Head Cook of the opposite gender
- both men and women will be called to serve as Co-Rectors/as and Co-Cooks
- the same number of team members will be called as for a single gender weekend; team will be equitably divided between men and women, as far as that is possible
- decurias (tables) will be segregated by gender
- it is recommended that the first two lay rollos be given by a man and a woman, so that participants understand right away that both men and women will speak
- participants and the Rollo Team will sleep in the gym, with men and women separated by a barrier
- when differences arise between how men and women are accustomed to doing things on the weekend, we resolve to encompass the best of both practices
- the Secretariat reaffirms its commitment to assisting the Rector/a in making this weekend one of service to God and to the participants

In 2010, we will have 2 single gender weekends again. If the Co-ed weekend is a success, we will have another in 2011. The plan is to rotate Co-ed weekends with single gender weekends every other year.

We meet the second Monday 10 months of the year at 6:30pm at Our Saviour's Lutheran Church youth room. We will meet on April 13th, May 11th, June 8th and August 13th.

Tirosh Update

As most of you know, the Tirosh Committee postponed Tirosh #15 as it was unable to call a Girls' Lay Director. As the committee wrestled with why this happened, we felt that God was asking us to step back and evaluate what Tirosh was trying to do.

A special meeting was held on January 25th, with the Tirosh and SALVdC communities well represented. After much discussion, all in attendance agreed the Tirosh is not serving the youth of our community very well in its present form. For Tirosh to be relevant, we need to support community youth programs. A recommendation was made to temporarily disband the Tirosh Committee and a task force be formed, made up of concerned members of the Tirosh/SALVdC community, to address this issue.

The recommendation was taken to Secretariat, where it was approved. Secretariat gave the task force six months to come up with a formal plan on how Tirosh can best support the community youth programs. The task force will provide monthly progress reports to Secretariat at its monthly meeting.

SECRETARIAT ROLES

Some of you may wonder just what it is the people do who serve on Secretariat. Here is a quick synopsis of two of the positions.

POST WEEKEND

The Post Weekend position is currently held by Laura Eskridge from Our Saviour's Lutheran Church. Per Laura, "This year I scheduled the Ultreyas and made schedule changes when needed. I send reports to the Secretariat and send notices of the Ultreyas to the SALVdC webmaster, who posts them on our website."

TREASURER

The Treasurer position was held by Linda Kress for two years. Per Linda, "The Treasurer for SALVdC accounts for the monies of the Secretariat. I paid the bills for material for the weekend retreats, National Convention delegate free, newsletters, mailings, Arizona Corporation Commission fees, and liability insurance. We are now required to file a tax form electronically as of 2008; so for we have not owed any taxes.

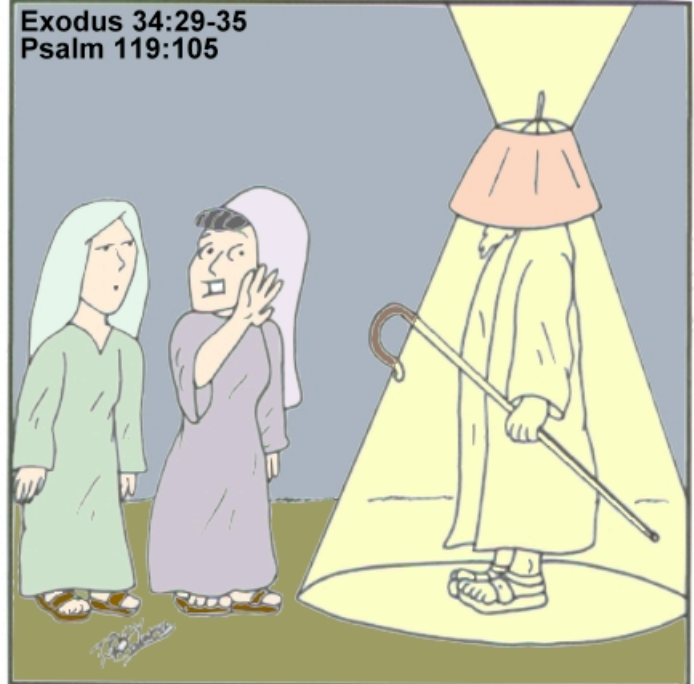

I keep all the information in a computer program, QuickBooks, for tracking and ease of reporting for our yearly Arizona Corporation Commission report, the Audit Committee, and the community at large.
