## Mañanitas

Regina Cleri will open to the Community at 4:45am on the Sunday mornings of Mañanitas. Please do not arrive before 4:45am or you will have to wait outside in the parking lot. Park in the east side parking lot, which is closest to the Rollo Room and Chapel. Members of the Cook Team or Community will be there to direct you. Do not try to enter any of the buildings until they direct you.

There will be labeled sheets on the tables in the Rollo Room for you to sign with your greetings to participants. Please do not leave gifts of any kind at the participants' places at the tables in the Rollo Room.

The morning service of **Mañanitas** for both the Men's and Women's weekends will begin in the Chapel at 5:30am sharp. Don't be late, it gets crowded. Remember that the Community is to remain separate from the participants **before, during and after** this service!

**Clausura** begins at 4:30pm on Sunday afternoon. Clausura will be held in the Chapel on the Men's weekend and in Gerke Hall on the

Women's weekend.

## Palanca

Remember to bring Palanca along to Regina Cleri on Thursday when you deliver participants. You may leave Palanca in the marked box on the loading dock by the kitchen. Don't wait until Sunday morning to bring Palanca, because the cooks need time to get it sorted before the last Palanca break. Bring all Palanca early in the weekend, please.

To help out those busy cooks, please alphabetize Palanca and separate it into bundles for participants, cooks and rollistas. This will make the job of sorting it in the Palanca room much easier.

## Sponsors

Sponsors are asked to be especially aware of their responsibilities toward their participants:

Sponsors are to make two banners for each man, one banner for each married woman and two banners for each single woman. Sponsors are also responsible for helping each husband to make a banner for his wife. Each banner must have a card pinned to the back which clearly says who the banner is for

and who it is from.

In addition, sponsors are to transport, or arrange transportation for, their participants to Regina Cleri on Thursday evening, help them register and take belongings to the sleeping quarters, bring palanca including a book and the required banners **early in the weekend** (so the cooks don't have to worry about this, too!) and transport the participants home on Sunday after Clausura.

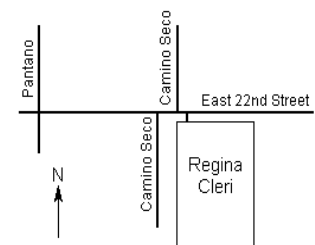
Sponsors also help their participants to find a group, and encourage them to attend Leadership School and Ultreyas.

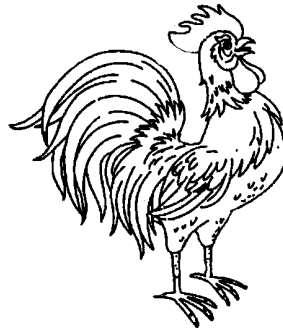
