### Mañanitas

Regina Cleri will open to the Community at 4:45am on the Sunday mornings of Mañanitas. Please do not arrive before 4:45am or you will have to wait outside in the parking lot. Park in the east side parking lot, which is closest to the Rollo Room and Chapel. Members of the Cook Team or Community will be there to direct you. Do not try to enter any of the buildings until they direct you.

There will be labeled sheets on the tables in the Rollo Room for you to sign with your greetings to participants. Please do not leave gifts of any kind at the participants' places at the tables in the Rollo Room.

The morning service of **Mañanitas** for both the Men's and Women's weekends will begin in the Chapel at 5:30am sharp. Don't be late, it gets crowded. Remember that the Community is to remain separate from the participants **before, during and after** this service!

**Clausura** begins at 4:30pm on Sunday afternoon. Clausura will be held in Gerke Hall on the Men's weekend and in Gerke Hall on the Women's weekend.

### Palanca

Remember to bring Palanca along to Regina Cleri on Thursday when you deliver participants. You may leave Palanca in the marked box on the loading dock by the kitchen. Don't wait until Sunday morning to bring Palanca, because the cooks need time to get it sorted before the last Palanca break. Bring all Palanca early in the weekend, please.

To help out those busy cooks, please alphabetize Palanca and separate it into bundles for participants, cooks and rolistas. This will make the job of sorting it in the Palanca room much easier.

### Sponsors

Sponsors are responsible for banners. Each participant is to receive ONE banner, measuring 24" by 36". Male participants and single women participants receive a banner made by their sponsors. Banners for married women participants are to be made jointly by husbands and sponsors. Pin a card to the back of each banner clearly saying who the banner is for and who it is from. Banners should be brought to Regina Cleri on Thursday night and delivered to the cooks. Sponsors also palanca one book for each participant.

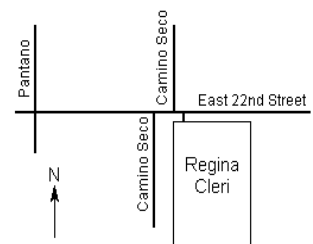
