What should we do during this Lenten time?

How can we make Lent meaningful to us this year?

How do we prepare ourselves for Easter Sunday?

Lent is not just additional worship services, or giving up chocolate. It is an idea of opening our hearts up to encounter God more deeply. How do we do that? Here are some suggestions.

1. Start with a time of self-examination. Spend time in prayer asking God to reveal areas of your life that need attention. Are you drifting away? What habits are pulling you away from Him?
2. Choose 1 or 2 things to focus on. Pick one thing to give up and one thing to add. Then stick with them for 40 days.
3. Find accountability. Share your plan with someone, check in weekly with them. Sharing a commitment can strengthen the resolve to stick with it.
4. If possible, attend extra services. Take this time to reflect on you and your relationship with God.
5. Read through the Gospels. Slowly walk through Matthew, Mark, Luke, or John. Take the time to experience Jesus's journey toward Jerusalem and the cross.
6. Time to confess. Use this Lenten season to personally confess sin and receive God's forgiveness and grace. Give it to God.
7. Prepare for Easter morning, realize that this is a time to celebrate. Why? The fact is that because Jesus died for you and rose from the grave, you have a new life in Christ. Christ is risen; He is risen indeed. Alleluia!

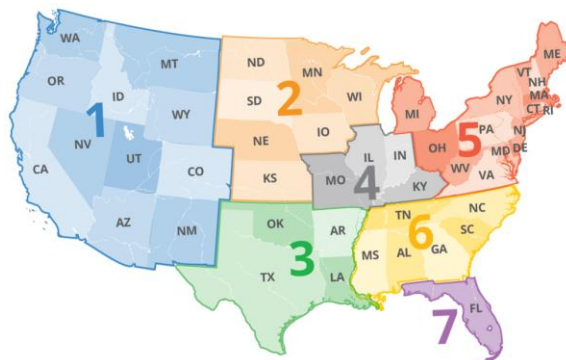
