Welcome and De Colores to our new Spiritual Director for Southern Arizona Via de Cristo, Pastor Mark Perry! Pastor Perry attended Arizona Lutheran Cursillo #35 in Phoenix, and then served as a Spiritual Director on weekends #43 and #53 and as Head Spiritual Director on #59. He also served for four years as Spiritual Director for the Arizona Lutheran Cursillo Secretariat. In addition, Pastor Perry was a Spiritual Director for both the original Tirosh retreat held at Adobe Mountain Juvenile Detention Center for Boys. and for Chayah #13, an ecumenical outgrowth of Tirosh, held at Black Canyon School for Girls. Since moving to Tucson in 2001 he has served in the Boys' Vineyard as a Spiritual Director for SALT #8. Pastor Perry's wife Linda and daughter Jenna are also active in Via de Cristo and Tirosh.

Pastor Perry writes: "Via de Cristo is the best intentional ministry that I know of in the Lutheran church for demonstrating and providing the opportunity of experiencing God's love. Many leaders and pastors on fire for the Lord with whom I have served in congregational settings have come out of a Cursillo-type experience. It is a privilege and a joy to be called to serve in this kind of role again. 
## The Call to Team

Earlier this year, Larry Paxton and Joanna Jongsma were called to serve as rector and rectora for Men's #15 and Women's #16, respectively. Soon afterward, Larry and Joanna began to call their core teams — head spiritual directors, head cooks, co-rectors, and co-rectoras — and soon this group of people will begin to call others to serve on team.

To be eligible for a call to team, a person must have attended a Leadership School, must regularly attend Ultreyas, and must be grouping. The names of those who are eligible for call are listed, and this list of names is prayed over by the core team. With God's direction, various people from this list are identified as possible team members, and they are then called to serve as a cook or rollista.

One of the goals of each core team is to ensure that someone from each church in the Via de Cristo community is called to team. However, not everyone who is called is able to serve. If you are hoping to be called to team, you may sign up at the next Ultreya, or you may contact the rector or rectora directly, to indicate your willingness to serve. While signing up or otherwise volunteering does not guarantee that you will be called, it may be that your action in identifying yourself is an answer to prayer.

If you are called to team, please pray before making your decision. Being a team member requires a real sacrifice of time and self: you must attend all team meetings, you must devote yourself to your fellow team members and to the participants who will attend the weekend, and you must immerse yourself in prayer. If the circumstances of your life do not allow you to make these sacrifices at this time, then please decline the call and remain open to being called again in the future. There are many ways to serve other than being on team!
