- You must get the card from a VdC representative
- Gift Cards have an initial value of \$5.00. You only need one card.
- You can recharge the Gift Card at any time. The card can be recharged at any register in the store or at the Customer Service Center for any denomination between \$5 and \$500. You can use cash or a credit/debit card to recharge the Gift Card.
- When you make a purchase using the Gift Card, the balance remaining on the Gift Card will be printed at the bottom of the register receipt
- If the magnetic strip on the back of the card will not work and the card number cannot be keyed in at the register, contact the Fry's Consumer Services Department (1-800-828-5235) and you will be issued another card for the balance that is on the original card
- Recharges to the card need to be done before the cashier starts to ring up the order, so that your purchases go towards supporting VdC

Gift Cards are like cash; if they are lost or stolen, they will not be replaced

5% of everything you spend using that card comes back to Via de Cristo.

... A note from Betty Whaples; Former Rectora for SALVdC # 24

On Saturday, January 19, 2008 we held an Ultreya at Streams in the Desert for our own VdC community members. There are 26 VdC members at Streams and 20 of them attended this Ultreya.

Our Ultreya followed the same format used at Ultreyas held for the general community: We had music, food, food, and more food. Scotty Gulbrandsen gave a witness talk, which was followed by grouping. We also participated together in communion and prayer.

At Streams we intend to hold these congregational Ultreyas during the months in which there are none for the general community, but as of writing this we have not yet decided on what day of the week to schedule them. We may try Pastor Tom's suggestion of scheduling them on Sunday evenings; then people can be reminded to attend during the Sunday morning services.

It feels really good to have the opportunity to attend an Ultreya every month!
