Giftcard Fundraiser



- You must get the card from a VdC representative
- Gift Cards have an initial value of \$5.00. You only need <u>one</u> card.
- You can recharge the Gift Card at any time. The card can be recharged at any register in the store or at the Customer Service Center for any denomination between \$5 and \$500. You can use cash or a credit/debit card to recharge the Gift Card.
- When you make a purchase using the Gift Card, the balance remaining on the Gift Card will be printed at the bottom of the register receipt
- If the magnetic strip on the back of the card will not work and the card number cannot be keyed in at the register, contact the Fry's Consumer Services Department (1-800-828-5235) and you will be issued another card for the balance that is on the original card
- Recharges to the card need to be done <u>before</u> the cashier starts to ring up the order, so that your purchases go towards supporting VdC

Gift Cards are like cash; if they are lost or stolen, they will not be replaced





Help Reduce Our Costs

Your Via de Cristo newsletter will arrive faster, with color graphics, and at less cost to the community if you are able to receive it via e-mail. To receive your newsletter electronically, simply log on to the Southern Arizona Via de Cristo web page at www.soazviadecristo.org, go to the Via de Cristo Homepage, and click on "Add your e-mail address to our Via de Cristo mailing list." On the next screen, click on Sign-up, and then supply the information requested: Your name, e-mail address, and church. You will also enter a password, which you can use to modify your information if that is ever needed. That's all it takes! The newsletter will arrive in your e-mail inbox as soon as it is published, in Adobe Acrobat .pdf format. If you do not have the Adobe Acrobat reader on your computer, you may download it free of charge at www.adobe.com or from the Newsletters page on the Via de Cristo web site.

The National Lutheran Secretariat no longer snail-mails its newsletter *Conexiones*, but publishes it only on the NLS website and through e-mail. In the future SALVdC may have to do the same. In the meantime, thank you for helping us to speed up the delivery of your newsletter, and also to save on printing costs and postage, by signing up to receive your newsletter online.
