Is that He gave everything.

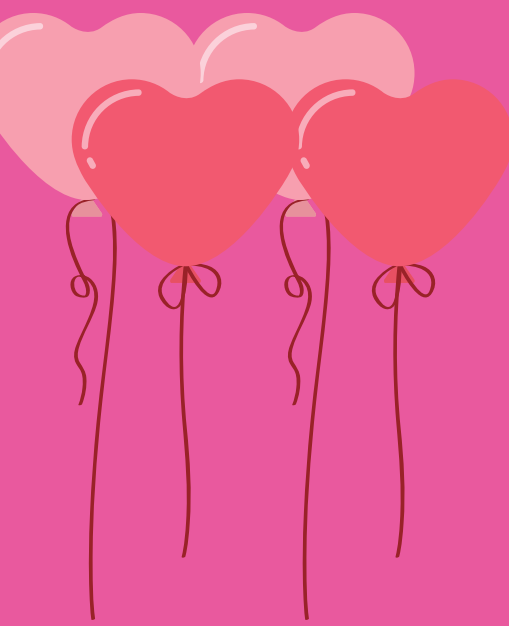
